The Mater Lathe Lamp is a contemporary and sculptural piece of luminaire designed by the Danish architects Jesper K. Thomsen and Sanne Traberg. The body and legs of the lamp is turned in wood after old crafts traditions. The name of the lamp (Lathe) refers to the small turning tool the craftsmen uses when making the body and legs. The wire is mounted alongside the pole with small rubber rings.

The oak wood is sustainably sourced from well-managed forests and thereby honouring the UN Sustainable Development Goals of protecting “*Life on Land*” (SDGs 15) and “*Responsible Consumption and Production*” (SDGs 12) and supporting “*Partnership for the Goals*” (SDGs 17).
