




RAIL

- PARTS -




Place the first rail (A) on the desired position on the wall and put the screw (B) into the wall through the top hole. Depends on the wall type, pre-drilling and wall plug (not included) maybe required.


Use the top hole as an achor point and level the rail straight then mark the screw hole with a pencil or a sharp tool on the wall.



Finish mounting the first rail by putting the screws (B) into the marked position. Measure the distances for the second rail (A), then mount the second rail by repeating the same process on page 4.




To extend the system, repeat the same process on page 4 and 5.

C Bolt x4




Threaded insert x2




E Spacing

Only (A), (B), (C) are required for this assembly.


Start by inserting bracket ends B into the holes on the shelf A.




Place the shelf at a desired position in the rail, secure the bracket (B) to the rail by fastening the bolts (C) to the threaded hole in the rail.



Note that the back side of the shelf should be placed against the rail not to the wall.





SINGLE SHELF






A Shelf x1

B Bracket x2


Start by inserting bracket ends B into the holes on the shelf A.




Make sure that the brackets are placed correct side.

Place the complete shelf against the wall, level it straight then mark screw holes with a pencil or a sharp tool on the wall.






Put screws into the marked position on the wall, then hang the bracket on. Depends on the wall type, pre-drilling and wall plug (not included) maybe required.




HANGER SHELF

- PARTS -




Only (A), (B), (C), (D), (F) are required for this assembly.


Start by screwing the hanger bolts $\widehat{\mathbb{F}}$ into the hanger $\widehat{\mathbb{B}}$ though the shelf $\widehat{\mathbb{A}}$.




Insert bracket ends \bigcirc into the holes on the shelf \bigcirc .




Place the shelf at a desired position in the rail, secure the bracket \bigcirc to the rail by fastening the bolts \bigcirc to the threaded hole in the rail.




Note that the back side of the shelf should be placed against the rail not to the wall.






SHELF LIBRARY CABINET

- PARTS -




Fasten the side panels (\mathbb{N}) to the back panel (\mathbb{K}) using the back screws (\mathbb{A}) , spacers (\mathbb{B}) and nuts (\mathbb{E}) . Make sure to start with the 2 center holes of the back panel (\mathbb{K}) .




NOTES: Do not completly fasten the nuts before the end.

Make sure to be two persons for assembly

Once screwed, place it flat on the back.




Next insert the screws (C), nuts (E) and spacers (B) between top part (L) and bottom part (M) to the side panels (N)




NOTE: Do not completly fasten the nuts before the end.

Then place the shelves \bigcirc inside the cabinet by screwing them with screws \bigcirc nuts \bigcirc , and spacers \bigcirc to the side panels \bigcirc .




NOTE: Do not completly fasten the nuts before the end.

Then rotate the cabinet on the bottom part (K).




Insert the back screws (A), nuts (E) and spacers (B) at the back of the cabinet.




NOTE: Do not completly fasten the nuts before the end.


You can now completly tighten all the nuts.



Fasten the mounting hooks (F) to the rails using the bolts (D), then place the cabinet on it.



Put the canvas curtain ① on the cabinet by placing the holes in the hooks.



NOTE: Different configurations with the curvas curtain are possible
